- What is the overall theme of these eight chapters?
- What are the names of the two kings that Israel conquered under Moses on the east side of the Jordan River?
- Which Israelite tribes asked to stay on the east side of the Jordan River?
- What message did the Lord have for Joshua at the beginning of chapter 13?
- God said in 13:6 "I myself will drive them out from before the people of Israel." Then, in verse 13 it says: Yet the people of Israel did not drive out the Geshurites or the Maacathites, but Geshur and Maacath dwell in the midst of Israel to this day. Why do you think this is?
- What lesson does this provide for us about the battles we fight in our Christian walk?
- In **chapter 14** Caleb is mentioned as a man who "**wholly followed the LORD**." What did he do to earn that title?
- How did the Lord reward Caleb?
- How does the attitude of Caleb differ from that of the other Israelites in these chapters?
- Read **chapter 17:12-13**. How did the Israelites compromise the command of the Lord concerning the people of the land?
- Chapter 18 tells us that the people set up the Tent of Meeting at Shiloh. What was the Tent of Meeting used for?
- In chapter 18 how did Joshua resolve the issue of seven tribes that had still not been allotted land?
- In chapter 19 the people obeyed the command of the Lord to do something special for Joshua. What was it?
- How does the taking of land by Israel relate to our own efforts to lay hold of the promises of God?
